

PERMISSION TO ENTER MALAYSIA FOR HOLDERS OF THE MM2H PASS

Following the introduction of the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) which took effect from the 14th of May 2020, **the Government has agreed to allow entrance of MM2H pass holders** that have been stranded overseas, subject to compliance to the following conditions:

- a) Permission is given only to those who have been identified and listed by the Ministry of Tourism Art and Culture (MOTAC);
- b) Permission is subject to inspection and compliance to the entry conditions set by the Immigration Department of Malaysia (JIM);
- c) Having undergone the swab test in the country in which they have been in the 14 days prior to arrival in Malaysia and having been tested negative to Covid-19;
- d) Submitting a declaration to bear the costs of quarantine in the quarantine centres identified.

These rules come into effect starting from the 18th of May 2020. All Directors of Immigration at State level and all Heads of Immigration in all points of entry are to execute these instructions without fail in cooperation with other Government agencies.
