Re-Entry Visa (National Visa)

General Documents Required

1. National Visa Application Form.

2. One recent [ICAO](#)-compliant photograph.

3. Proof of residence within the consular jurisdiction:

-Proof of legal residence in Malaysia, as long-term stay visa, must have a validity of at least three (3) remaining months.

4. Valid passport, original plus one photocopy, with an expiry date at least three months beyond the expiry date of the requested visa.

5. Letter from the applicant explaining the reasons for requesting the visa and the circumstances surrounding the loss of, or failure to renew, the residence permit.

6. Where the residence permit expired no more than 60 days before the application date:

- Original or copy of the expired residence permit;

AND

- Receipt confirming submission of the renewal application.

7. In the event that the residence permit has been **lost** or **stolen**:

- Copy of the relevant police report filed with the police authorities or the competent authorities of the country where the loss or theft occurred, duly apostilled/Legalized and translated where necessary.

8. Medical documentation, where applicable, if the applicant remained abroad beyond the validity of the residence permit for health-related reasons.

9. Any additional supporting documentation, where applicable.

Note:

-After the application has been submitted, the visa office needs to be authorised from the Questura (Police station) which originally issued the permesso di soggiorno. The visa is issued only after the relevant

Questura releases the necessary authorisation. Therefore, it is not possible to rush the processing time.

-Once the authorisation has been received, the applicant must provide one-way flight reservation. If the trip includes multiple stops, provide reservations for any intra-stop (trains, flights, car rentals).
